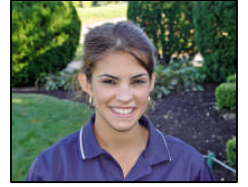

Five league matches in five days is a lot of golf! But the 2006 Colonials overcame a tough 9-stroke loss to the undefeated Upper Dublin Cardinals at Old York Road CC on Wednesday, by rebounding to a **200-206 win over Wissahickon** at Horsham Valley CC to up their 2nd place league record to a successful 12-2-0 season with two matches remaining (Oct 6th at Green Valley CC versus Upper Merion & Oct 9th at Upper Moreland).

We are pleased to announce that **six Colonial golfers** (pictured above) have **qualified for the 2006 Suburban One League Championships**. This year the league went to a new format to decide which golfers qualify for the tournament. Using an excel program, individual golfers scores were recorded using the 9-hole scores, the course rating and slope to determine a handicap differential (see example below of one of James Braunsberg scores this season). Each golfers best seven scores were to be averaged.

As of this past Friday, the **top 88 golfers** were named to the **2006 SOL Golf Tournament**. Just to let you know how tough it can be to qualify, here are the numbers for the cut line: #88 Danny Walck (Pennridge) 6.311, #89 Alex Jeffers (Neshaminy) 6.312, Ryan King (Pennsbury) 6.314. *One one-thousandth of a point...who says every stroke counts? Every golf coach!* Here are the PW numbers for 7-13 scores (*not counting last Wednesday's UD match because their coach forgot to send in our scores*): #17 James Braunsberg (2.50), #73 Trevor Urban (5.78), #74 Vinny Greco (5.79), #76 Nolan McMahon (5.92) and #86 Shane Dolan (6.26). Our 6th golfer is junior Gia Bradley who will be representing PWHS at the **SOL Girl's Tournament at Doylestown CC** on Wednesday.

The Colonials led off the week with a solid 210-221 win over **Springfield** at the Flourtown CC. James Braunsberg's 39 led the Colonials, while Pete Hackenbrack and Nolan McMahon both shot 41's. Junior Kevin Dick, playing in his first varsity match, figured in the top-five PW scores with a 45. At Green Valley CC the next afternoon, PW was led by Trevor Urban (41) and Vinny Greco (43) and defeated **Methacton by 30 strokes** (222-252).

At Old York Road, in a battle for **first place in the American Conference**, the totals after six scores were tied at 222-222; but the Cardinal's 7th and 8th golfers shot 41 & 43 to give **Upper Dublin a 213-222 win** and capture this year's league title. James Braunsberg and Vinny Greco both led PW with 42's. On Thursday at the short Horsham Valley GC, PW secured 2nd place in the league with a **clutch 200-206 win over Wissahickon**. James was again low man for PW with a 37, followed by Nolan McMahon and Pete Hackenback who both carded 40's. Shane Dolan also added a 41 and captain Trevor Urban shot a 42. The Colonials finished the busy week with a **209-231 win over Upper Merion at Gulph Mills CC**. James Braunsberg shot a 38, while Trevor Urban's 40 helped him qualify for the 2006bSuburban One Golf Tournament.

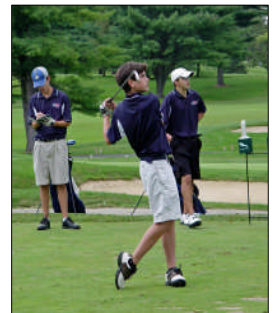
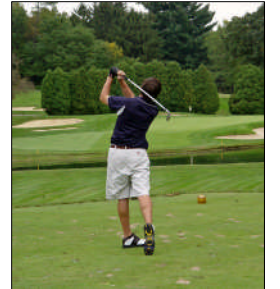
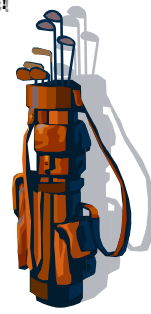
