PW golfers remain undefeated (8-0) with half the season completed. 2nd place Wissahickon also undefeated. Colonials defeat Springfield (202-249) at Green Valley CC. Round of 42 not good enough to score for PWHS. PW's V2 team opens season with impressive 17-stroke (209-226) win vs. Wissahickon at Horsham Valley CC



This week, the **Plymouth Whitemarsh High School** golf team reached the *halfway point* of the 2007 season with a **perfect 8-0 record** and two solid 2nd-place finishes in two tournaments. All of their league matches have been "blow-outs", with the exception on their match with Upper Dublin, who the Colonials defeated by one stroke back in August. PW has four *home* (Quakertown, Cheltenham, Wissahickon & Upper Merion) and four *away* (Upper Dublin, Upper Merion, Methacton & Wissahickon) matches remaining. Even though the Colonials have one varsity match scheduled this week, it features a key re-match on Wednesday between PWHS and Upper Dublin at LuLu Country Club.

On Friday, PW put up five strong scores under 42 to record a **47-stroke win (202-249) over**

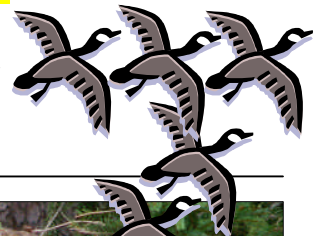
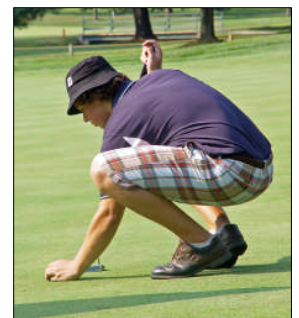
visiting Springfield. James Braunsberg, Pete Hackenbrack and Christian Koniewicz all shot 40's while teammates Trevor Urban and Shane Dolan each shot 41. On Wednesday, the **V2 team**, under the direction of PW assistant coach, Ryan Zehren (pictured in golf cart), traveled to Horsham Valley CC to defeat Wissahickon's JV team by 17 strokes (209-226). **Kevin Dick and Will Peuser led PW** with 40's while Tom Barlow's 41, Dave Piacitelli's 43 & Matt "GQ" Rowe's 45 completed the scoring for the Colonials. Sophomore Jason Rosenbaum, one of two new golfers added to the team this season, also shot a 45 for 9-holes.



On Friday, the **first 2007 SOL HANDICAP DIFFERENTIALS** (determines which **82** SOL golfers will qualify for the 2007 Suburban One Golf Tournament at Indian Valley CC on October 2nd) were published. To qualify, a golfer must have a minimum of eight scores. Here are the current numbers and placements for the eight PWHS varsity golfers. **9TH: BRAUNSBURG** 2.95 (7), **16TH: URBAN** 3.87 (7), **33RD: MCMAHON** 4.96 (7), **51ST: HACKENBRACK** 5.85 (7), **70TH: KISSELL** 6.63 (4), **77TH: DOLAN** 6.96 (7), **98TH: GRECO** 8.05 (7) **99TH: KONIEWICZ** 8.09 (6). With six matches remaining before Suburbans, each round is very important! The matches not yet included in the totals are the Pinecrest and CR South Invitational scores and last Friday's home match with Springfield.
